A special Shinnenkai:

This time our New Year gathering will not be preceded by a financial market outlook. In commemoration of the 150 year anniversary of the signing of the Friendship Treaty between Switzerland and Japan, Dr. Dieter Schwarz, Director of the Kunstmuseum Winterthur, will elaborate on ‚Japonisme‘ referring to some outstanding paintings of the collection of the museum. The term ‚Japonisme‘ was created at about the time when Japan opened up to foreign interests e.g. roughly when the treaty was signed. ‚Japonisme‘ relates to the importance of a movement which begun to shake the foundations of European art and artistic taste. It opened up entirely new prospects for the creation of a new visual reality, a modern style; it defines the impact of Japanese aesthetics on Western art.

A buffet with Japanese delicacies will be offered in the premises of the museum following the presentation.

Kunstmuseum Winterthur:

The Kunstmuseum Winterthur possesses one of the most beautiful modern art collections in Switzerland. The works of art reach from the 19th century to the present. Permanently shown are French art from the turn of the century (van Gogh, Monet, Bonnard, Vallotton), Cubism (Braque, Gris, Léger), modern classic art collections (Kandinsky, Klee, Magritte, Miró) and international contemporary art such as Kelly, Marden, Mangold, Tuttle, Kounellis, Merz, Richter, Schütte and others.
