**Abstract:** 

Watchmaking has been at the core of relations between Switzerland and Japan since

the end of the Edo period. Watch merchants from Neuchâtel were among the first

Swiss citizens to settle in Yokohama, opening a new market in East Asia. However,

Japan was not only a growing outlet but also a nation that built its own watch industry,

mostly based on two main companies (Seiko and Citizen). This lecture will hence

discuss two main aspects of relations concerning the watch trade of the two countries

between the 1860s and the 1930s: sales activities (the import and distribution of

watches by Swiss merchants) and industrial relations (technology transfer from

Switzerland and the investment of Swiss watchmakers in Japanese firms).

Prof. Dr. Pierre-Yves Donzé was born in La Chaux-de-Fonds and studied History at

the University of Neuchâtel, where he received his PhD in 2005. He is a Professor of

Business History at Osaka University since 2015 and Visiting Professor at the

University of Fribourg. He has published numerous books and articles on the history

of global business in a broad range of industries (including watches, fashion and

luxury, food, and medical devices).
